TOM's Rotary Club invites those who cannot join or rejoin the Club but who are prepared to assist with various community activities, to be admitted as TOM's Rotary Supporters.

1. **TOM's Rotary Supporters:**

- will be presented with an appropriate Club Name Badge;
- will be entitled to attend meetings of the Club, subject to giving notice to the current Club Service Director by 10 a.m. on the morning of the meeting – see Website for details of current Club Service Director www.tomsrotaryclub.org.au
- will be invited to nominate the areas in which they are interested in lending support;
- will be under no obligation to assist with any specific project but will simply make themselves available on request if it fits in with their other commitments or activities;
- will be invited to our Annual Christmas Function and to our Annual ChangeOver.

2. Membership of TOM's Rotary Supporters will be extended to any residents of the Manning Valley (male or female) who are interested in assisting with the charitable and community activities of TOM's Rotary Club.

3. Members of TOM's Rotary Supporters will not be required to pay any joining fee or annual fee.

4. As members of TOM's Rotary Supporters are not members TOM's Rotary Club, no record will be maintained of their attendance or non-attendance at dinner meetings.

5. The activities in which TOM's Rotary Supporters may register are as follows:

- hosting an exchange student

- working on the barbeque or in other ways to support the Manning River Discovery Day – food and music to be provided at different destinations on the Manning Valley each year
- assisting with our annual gaming night
- assisting with the running of the Business House Relay at the Manning Aquatic Centre – generally in early December each year
- assisting in other activities and special projects not involving selling raffle tickets.
- assisting in other activities involving selling raffle tickets.

6. TOM Rotary Supporters who host exchange students or have other involvement with youth will have to sign the standard declaration under our District Youth Protection Policy and will have to be approved by the Board.
